<u>Educational Costs</u> – Costs may vary, but the below costs should give a good approximation. We, as a program, would like to be as transparent as possible regarding the educational costs of the program.

- A. Tuition- Fall, Spring and Summer semesters
  - a. Resident of Kansas, Missouri, Nebraska, Colorado, Oklahoma, and Texas: \$338 per credit hour (2023-24)
  - b. Non-Resident: \$731 per credit hour (2023-24)
  - c. Online courses (AL 268 and AL 271): \$439 per credit hour (2023-24)
  - d. Activity Fee: \$55 (Fall and Spring Semesters only)
- B. PTA Textbooks/Lab Fees approximate figure: \$1,010
- C. Criminal Background check: \$50 \$100
