To access online courses, faculty and students should login to MyWashburn at my.washburn.edu. Direct access to your online courses is located on the MyCourses tab in MyWashburn by clicking on the course name. Online courses may also be accessed directly through Desire2Learn at https://d2l.washburn.edu/. Login using your MyWashburn username and password. Students should also change their MyWashburn time out setting from the default value in "My Account Preferences" inside MyWashburn to at least 120 minutes to avoid timing out while working in an online course. Care should be taken to log out completely when finished. All students enrolled in online courses have access to the Desire2Learn Student Orientation. To access the Student Orientation, in D2L, click My Home in the upper left. Then click the Help drop-down menu and choose Student Help. Students new to online classes are strongly encouraged to review the orientation material before or during the first week of classes.

The student orientation covers each of the tools and answers some of the most commonly asked questions.
