TITLE: Non-Nobis Solum Funding

ORIGINATOR: Senator Soliday

SPONSOR: Smith/ Campa Administration, Senator Young, Chairperson Smith, Senator Alcantara, Senator King, Chair-Person Hanes, Senator Leffingwell

STATUS: Campus and Community Affairs Committee- Favorable

WHEREAS: The current COVID-19 pandemic has impacted students negatively, and

WHEREAS: Washburn Student Government Association has an excess of unused funds from the 2019-2020 budget, and

WHEREAS: Washburn Student Government Association strives to meet its motto, “Students Serving Students”, and

WHEREAS: The University guides itself on the motto “Non Nobis Solum” or Not for us alone, and

WHEREAS: Many students could benefit from the excess of funds.

THEREFORE BE IT ENACTED:

SECTION ONE: Allocations committee shall suspend funding policies on an as needed basis if student organizations are requesting money to recover themselves from the current pandemic or provide services to others.

SECTION TWO: The Washburn Student Government Association shall allocate excess funds from the 2019-2020 Fiscal year not to exceed an overall amount of \$25,000 to respond to the negative effects of the current pandemic.

~~SECTION THREE: \$20,000 of the money allocated shall go to the University’s current COVID-19 response funds. With a request that the money shall go to students that are unable to access the CARES ACT funding such as International Students and DACA students. As well as having at least one WSGA member on the committee in charge of dispersing the funds.~~

SECTION FOUR: \$10,000 of the money allocated shall go to Bods Feeding Bods to help in their efforts to serve students who are currently unable to afford food.

SECTION FIVE: \$15,000 of the money allocated shall be used to boost the morale of the student body through giveaways and other programming efforts following CDC guidelines. The Campus and Community affairs will be in charge of implementing such efforts as well as maintaining the budget given.

SECTION SIX: The Budget Director as well as the advisor will be in charge of ensuring that the funds be disbursed as quickly as possible.

SECTION SEVEN: This legislation shall become effective upon passage.
